



SYSTEM DESCRIPTION

The System usually comprises one Master Control Panel and a number of remote Fire Telephones. The System allows two way calling and speech between any Fire Telephone and the Master. The Master can also connect telephones together and hold group conversations.

SYSTEM INTEGRITY

The System is fully monitored, including field cables, for faults, whilst the System has battery back-up as standard to allow continued operation in the event of mains failure.

PRODUCT BENEFITS

As well as meeting all current National and Local Authority requirements and standards, the Firetalk 350 System also has the following benefits:

- **System capacity.** The System allows expansion of a single exchange from 5 lines to 250 lines, in jumps of 5.
- **Remote operation.** Additional remote master panels can be added to the System.
- **Fault monitoring.** Clean contacts are provided to forward fault information to external systems.
- **Choice of telephone units.** The standard unit is supplied for flush or surface mounting, with a choice of cast aluminium handle, or push open catch. Vandal resistant, weatherproof, explosionproof or desk top styles are also available, whilst customer requirements, ie: stainless steel doors, etc. can be accommodated.
- **External call devices.** External Xenon flashing beacons and sounders can be connected, without the need for extra cabling or local power supplies.
